

2006 Monsanto Hispanic Network Scholarship

The Monsanto Hispanic Network Scholarship is designed to help subsidize a Hispanic student's college education. The program was established in 2001, awarding four of the most deserving high school graduates and college students a scholarship of one thousand five hundred dollars each.

Eligibility and Requirements:

To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Applicants must be of Hispanic descent. (Note: Monsanto employees, their spouses and children are not eligible.)
- 2. All applicants must be U.S. residents.
- 3. Applicants must be enrolled at a university or college to be eligible. If applicant is a graduating high school senior, he/she must provide to the MHN scholarship committee a copy of the acceptance letter from the university he/she plans to attend.
- 4. Applicant must be attending or, if a high school student going to attend, a four-year university. Only undergraduate and high school students are eligible. Graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 5. The information provided on the application must be clear and complete.
- 6. All documentation must be submitted to be considered for the scholarship. This includes:
 - a. MHN Scholarship application
 - b. Cover letter
 - c. Applicant's resume
 - d. If a high school senior, the acceptance letter from his university
- 7. **All applications must be postmarked no later than May 19, 2006.** Applications received thereafter will not be considered. Winners will be notified in June of 2006 and all awards will be made in September of 2006.
- 8. The MHN scholarship committee desires to give the scholarship to majors that are related to Monsanto's business, however this requirement will only be used in the event of a tiebreak. These majors include: business, agriculture, the sciences, engineering, human resources, and information technology.
