What Does MPACT Provide?

MPACT provides

- > Training
- > Information
- One-to-One Support

- MPACT is funded through the U.S. Department of Education under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
- MPACT is Missouri's only Parent Training Information (PTI) center.
- MPACT collaborates with families, school districts and professionals.
- MPACT helps youth with disabilities with selfadvocacy.
- MPACT provides trainings on special education, parenting and current critical topics (i.e. McKinney-Vento, bullying and trauma).

How Does MPACT Provide Services?

Parent Advisors



Parent Advisors provide direct assistance to families and complete initial assessments. They also provide action plans, send resources, and help prepare families for IEP meetings.

Regional Coordinators



Regional Coordinators provide trainings, workshops, and presentations. They network with local agencies, assist families, attend meetings, and recruit and support Mentors.

Multi-Cultural Coordinators



Multi-cultural Coordinators have the same responsibilities as the Regional Coordinators. Their focus, however, is to serve the multi-faceted needs of the urban core populations.

Mentors



Mentors provide direct assistance to parents, help them prepare for meetings, and support parents in IEP meetings.
